- Hosted two ABC's of Dementia public presentations within the former Sunrise Health Region (e.g. attendees from Springside and Kelvington)
- Toured across 14 communities in the region to promote the project:
   Bredenbury, Canora, Churchbridge,
   Esterhazy, Kamsack, Langenburg,
   Melville, Norquay, Preeceville, Pelly,
   Saltcoats, Stenen, Sturgis, Yorkton
- Sent a mass ad-mail to all residents in the former Sunrise Health Region
- Responded to interest from contacts in Pelly, Stenen, Canora and Esterhazy to explore opportunities to build awareness and increase dementia friendliness
- Promoting the project on the Alzheimer Society's social media channels

- Monthly blogs featuring the collective impact project on Alzheimer Society website which are sent to contacts in the former Sunrise Health Region
- Preparing to launch new dementia friendly learning materials in Fall 2021
- Planning additional community visits to engage local organizations and community groups
- Discussion with SaskAbilities to become a formal referral partner in order to enable referrals by the First Link Coordinator to the Life Enrichment program
