



DEMENTIA FRIENDLY LIFE ENRICHMENT PROGRAM

THE DEMENTIA FRIENDLY LIFE ENRICHMENT PROGRAM:

- Provides individualized and group programming to individuals with dementia and their care partners.
- Reduces caregiver burnout by providing one to one service to those living with dementia.
- Assists to increase social connections amongst care partners and people living with dementia.
- Assists to increase natural supports within the community.
- Provides individuals with knowledge to decrease the stigma people face when living with dementia.
- Assists care partners navigate the care system.

FROM APRIL 2021 TO MARCH 2023, THE DEMENTIA FRIENDLY LIFE ENRICHMENT PROGRAM:

- Served individuals living with dementia and their care partners in 12 different communities: Tantallon, Esterhazy, Langenburg, Saltcoats, Kamsack, Canora, Amsterdam, Good Spirit, Yorkton, Springside, Theadore, and Melville.
- Travelled over 37,873 kilometers to provide supports to people living with dementia and their care partners.
- Provided over 1071 hours of support hours to individuals in the program.
- Over 645 engagements have occurred with people living with dementia and their care partners.
- 188 out of home supports to recreational facilities have been facilitated.
- To date, 54 individuals living with dementia and their care partners have accessed the program. Several participants in the program have remained in the program since its inception.
